BWSC Report - Larry Cato advised current projects are on hold or in process of obtaining project funding. Plan to have funding information available by next board meeting.

HKA Engineering - 2008 CDBG has been completed. Additional cleanup may be needed and will be covered under warranty. Faye Leonard will finalize the CDBG with a public hearing and an application has been submitted for the 2010 CDBG funding. Highway 141 Project should be bid in October. The state will be handling all water line relocations that may be required to the Wilson County line.

Superintendent's Report:

- Reviewed financial reports for August, 2010.
- Contract for the main sewer lift station awarded to Putnam Contracting for \$460,000.00 plus engineering fees.

- TDEC (Tennessee Department of Environment and Conservation) requirements include 12 hours of education for all board members. Upcoming utility conference information distributed and all board members and they were encouraged to attend if schedule allows.
- Office hours have been expanded from 7:00 a.m. through 5:00 p.m. Monday through Friday.
- Geological survey for future water plant site has been signed and returned to resolve the request from the Eastern Bank of Cherokee Indians.
- Update on FEMA submissions and pending reimbursements.
